During the period 1 to 30 September 1945, the battalion was occupied in redeploying troops. A security patrol and a riving road block were in operation as security measures.

During the period 1 to 31 October inclusive the battalion was occupied redeploying troops. A training schedule was in effect for that period stressing the points of orientation and redeployment.

On Thursday, 4 October the advance party left the area of NATTHEIM for the assembly area in France. Due to a change in orders, they returned Friday, 5 October.

Security patrols and roadblocks were in continual operation throughout the month.

A Battalion Review was held at 1000 on Wednesday, 31 October in honor of Major General Burrell and Brig General Holbrook.
